The next regular meeting of the Mansfield Aviation Club will be Saturday July 5th.

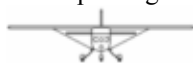

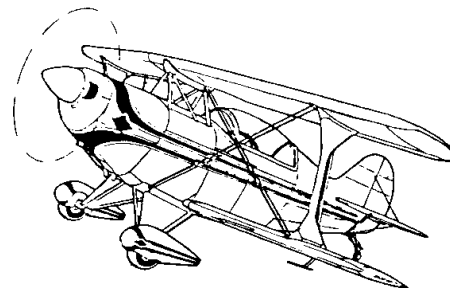

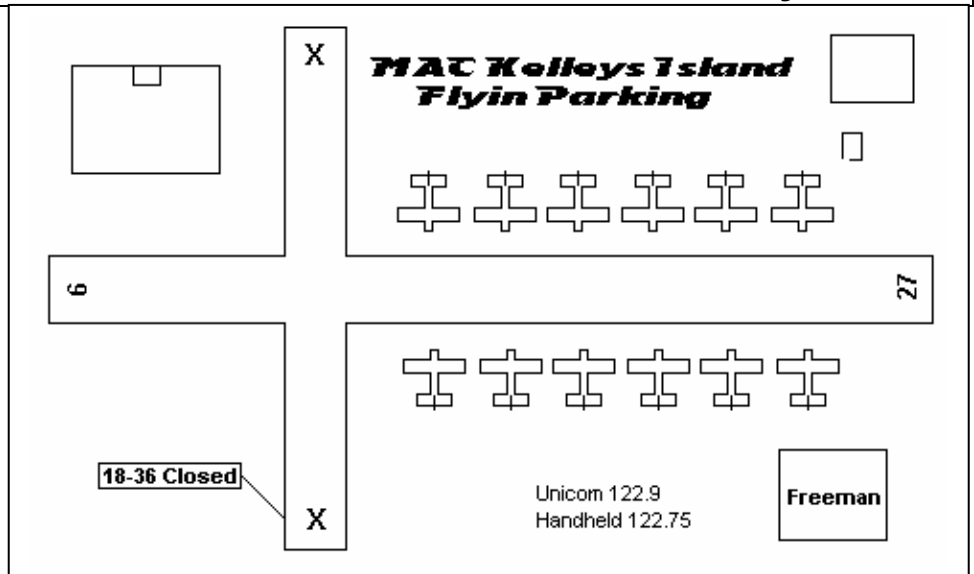
